## From 11.59pm this evening all of New Zealand is at Alert Level 4

Auckland and Coromandel will remain at Alert Level 4 for seven days.

The rest of New Zealand will be at Alert Level 4 and reviewed at three days.

### **Current situation**

There is one new case of COVID-19 in the community. The positive case was identified in Auckland and is now under investigation.

There are several locations of interest related to this case in Auckland and the Coromandel. Information about these locations of interest and the actions people should take is available on the Ministry of Health website: www.health.govt.nz

The case was a frequent user of the COVID tracer app, which has assisted public health officials in identifying locations of interests. Information about locations of interest will continue to be updated as new details become available.

ESR is currently carrying out urgent genome sequencing for the case, with results expected overnight. This will provide us with more information, however, we are assuming this is the delta variant. ## **Testing in Auckland and Coromandel**

DHBs are working on additional testing capacity on the North Shore and the Coromandel tomorrow (Wednesday).

Healthcare facilities remain open. The Ministry is reminding people if they are unwell to seek treatment promptly. Travel for health treatment is allowed under COVID-19 alert level four.

#### **Vaccination centres**

The vaccination programme will pause while arrangements for the continuing to vaccinate safely under alert level 4 are put in place.

People who have appointments that are affected will be contacted to provide information on rebooking. Everyone who has a booking in the system will still get vaccinated.
