1. Summary of COVID-19 cases and COVID-19 testing in Northland¹

1.1 COVID-19 cases

No new cases reported in the past 24 hours.

29 cases notified in Northland with no new cases in the community.

1.2. COVID-19 testing as at 0600 hours 19 August 2021

Testing volumes

- There were 1,007 tests done on Friday 20 August 2021
- There were 511 tests done on Saturday 21 August 2021
- There were 211 tests done on Sunday 22 August 2021
- 53,477 tests were completed as of 06:00 on 18 August 2021 across Northland.
- 59% of the tests done across Northland were done at the Community Based Testing Centres and Mobile testing clinics.

Tests related to Auckland cases

There were 452 tested using the Auckland surveillance codes, details of testing below:

- 27 tests done using the Auckland Hospital code (SURV-TM18ADHB & SURVADHB),
- 421 tests done using the latest Auckland cases code (SURV-TM18CC),
- 1 test done using the Wellington code (SURV-AUGWELL21),
- 1 test done using the Avondale College code (SURV-TM18SC1),
- 2 tests done using the Northcote College code (SURV-TM18SC2).

Results

- 90% of all tests done on 20 August 2021 have been processed and all are negative.
- 47% of all tests done on 21 August 2021 have been processed and all are negative.
- 13% of all tests done on 22 August 2021 have been processed and all are negative.

Symptomatic vs asymptomatic

• 34% of people who were tested were symptomatic, while 66% were asymptomatic.



4. Northland COVID-19 Testing


4.1. COVID-19 testing in Northland is carried out at:

- ✓ Community Based Testing Centres (CBTCs) currently operating across Northland (Kaitaia, Kaikohe, Rawene, Kerikeri, Kawakawa, Whangarei and Ruakaka),
- ✓ Primary care (GPs),
- ✓ Northland DHB hospitals (including Emergency department and wards),
- ✓ 24 Aged Residential Care (ARC) facilities,
- ✓ Mobile testing centres operated by Māori health providers to cover the remote and rural areas, and
- ✓ Specific testing sites continue to be operational for maritime testing. A testing centre operates at Refining NZ Visitor Centre, Ruakaka for maritime and border facing staff testing, and one-off testing of overseas travellers arriving by small boats/yachts occurs at Opua.

4.2. COVID-19 testing in Northland as of 06:00 on 23 August 2021

- 53,477 tests done in Northland to date across Primary care, Northland DHB hospitals, CBTCs, mobile testing and Aged Residential Care.
- 31,34 tests (59%) of all tests in Northland were done at the CBTCs and mobile testing.
- Due to recent cases in Auckland, testing stations across Northland have extended their hours of opening.
- Pohe Island Testing Centre in Whangarei has reopened due to expected increase in demand.


Figure 4.1: Northland COVID-19 testing for the last three days




Figure 4.2: Northland COVID-19 testing by testing facility as at 0600 hours 23 August 2021





Figure 4.4: Northland COVID-19 testing by testing facility in Northland from 05 March 2020 to 22 August 2021






Figure 4.3: COVID-19 tests – symptomatic vs asymptomatic as of 06:00 on 23 August 2021




