**KAI**

- Mere Apiata
  - A kai table has been set up out front of Te Tapui Marae, Matauri Bay for whanau, they must ring Mere
  - Top shop is still open for whanau to buy supplies.
- Bree
  - Working with staff and leaders about kai packs and how they could be safely distributed to whanau in need without putting staff and whanau at risk, with the Delta strain being easily contractable.
  - From Social Service perspective after talking to whanau, they are all doing ok kai wise, day 2 into lockdown.

**BORDER MANAGEMENT**

- Level 4 checkpoints are currently in place.
- Every hour from the time of announcement till 11.59pm there were at least 400 cars travelling north
- Only those fully vaccinated to be frontline
- Can marae, hapu stand with Whangaroa boarder control if needed?
- Whangaroa boarder control are looking at putting checkpoints in place
  - Chicken Stop
  - Others to be identified

Danni: Matauri Bay still has a lot of traffic going through.

**OTHER /WELLBEING**

- Many Marae are closed during lockdown.
  - If a tangihanga comes back to Whangaroa, the whanau will be escorted by police, straight to the urupa, limited to only 10 whanau members.
- Liarne has spoken with kohanga whanau and they are wanting information on what is the age limit to get vaccinated – to be supplied by coms
