Alert Level

- Northland is at Alert Level 2.

Cases

- There are **seven cases (2 new cases in the past 24 hours)** in Northland and **27** contacts being monitored by Public Health at the moment.

Locations of Interest and Contact Tracing

- There are **11** locations of interest identified by public health across Northland – please check the Ministry of Health for the updated LOI.
- All household contacts and close contacts are in isolation and regular testing and monitoring of symptoms is being undertaken by the Public Health Unit.

Testing

- **633** tests done on Sunday, 24 October, 2021.
- An increase in tests, especially in the Far North District since the recent Northland cases.
- **44%** of people who got tested yesterday identified as Māori.
- **20,432** tests done since 6 October.

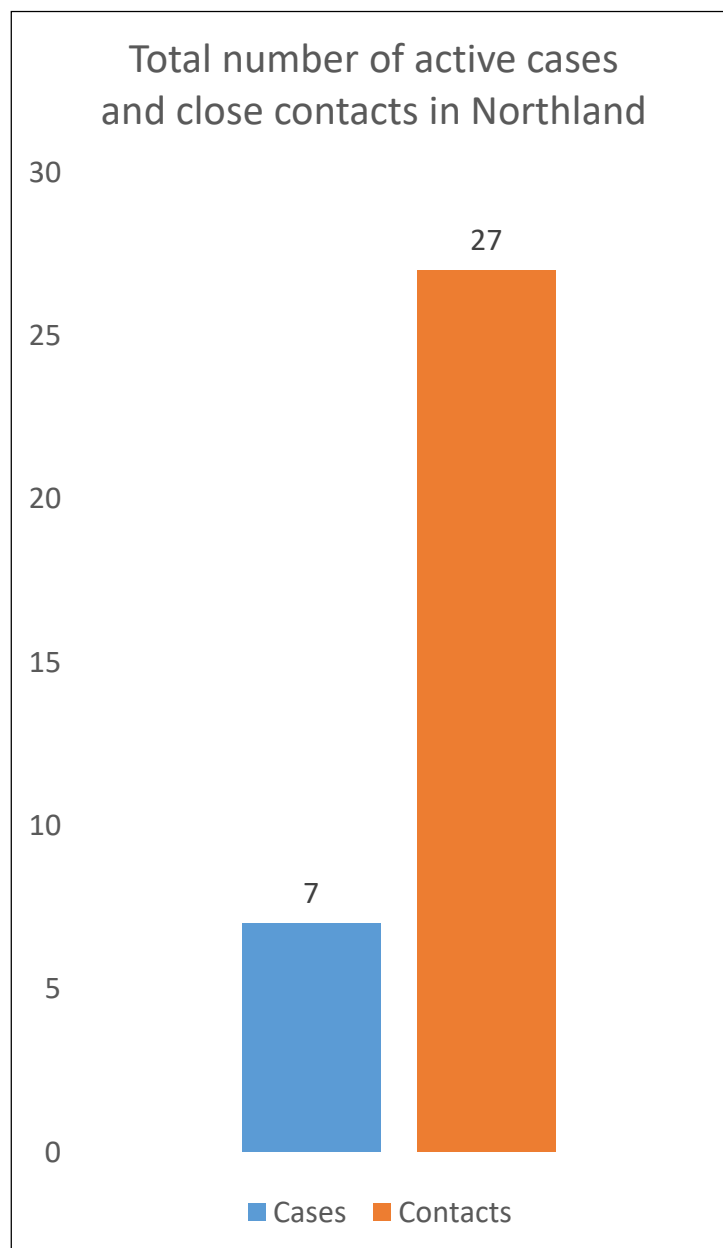
Vaccinations

- **218,755** doses have been administered across Northland as at 0600 hours 25 October 2021.
- **333** doses were administered on Saturday, 23 October, 2021. The number of doses administered has decreased this week.
- **73.1%** of the **164,646** Northland resident and eligible population (aged 12 years and above) have received at least one dose of the vaccine.
- **20,333 (39.2%)** of Northland Māori eligible population are yet to receive their first dose.
- **127** doses were administered to Māori in the Far North District in the past 24 hours.

- **7 cases** in Northland – now referred to as the ‘Northland cluster’
- **2 new cases** in Northland (associated with the same cluster) notified in the past 24 hours

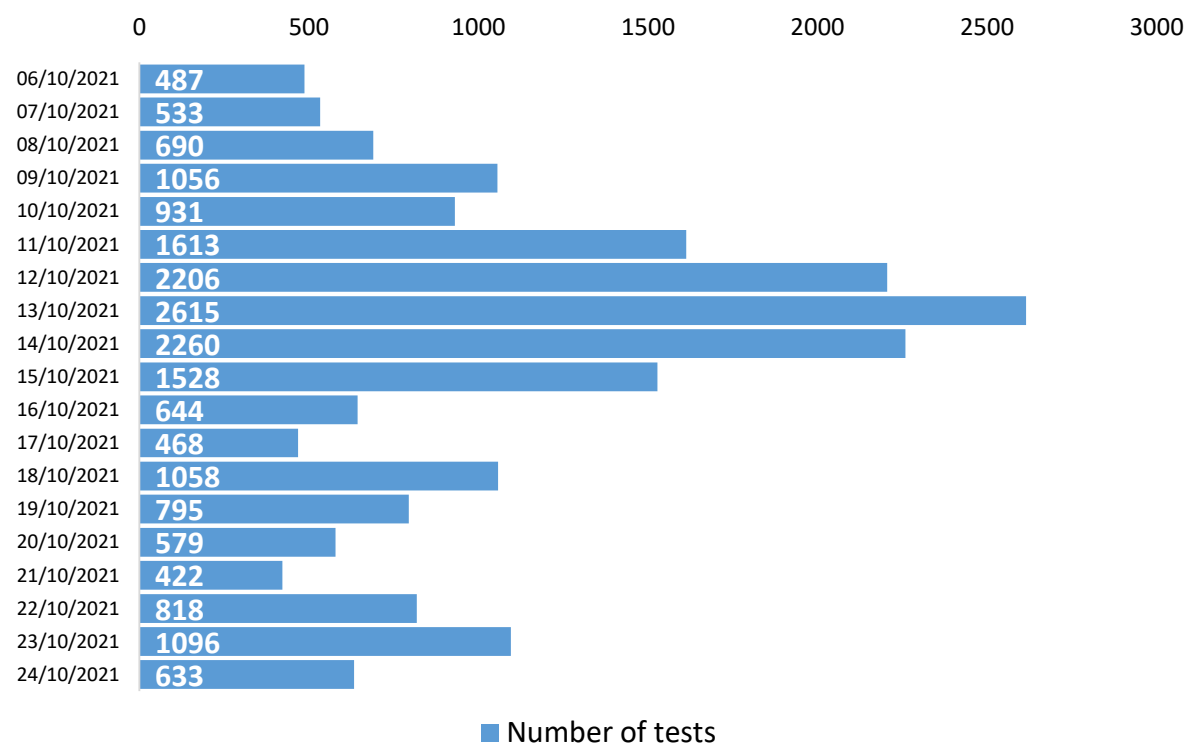

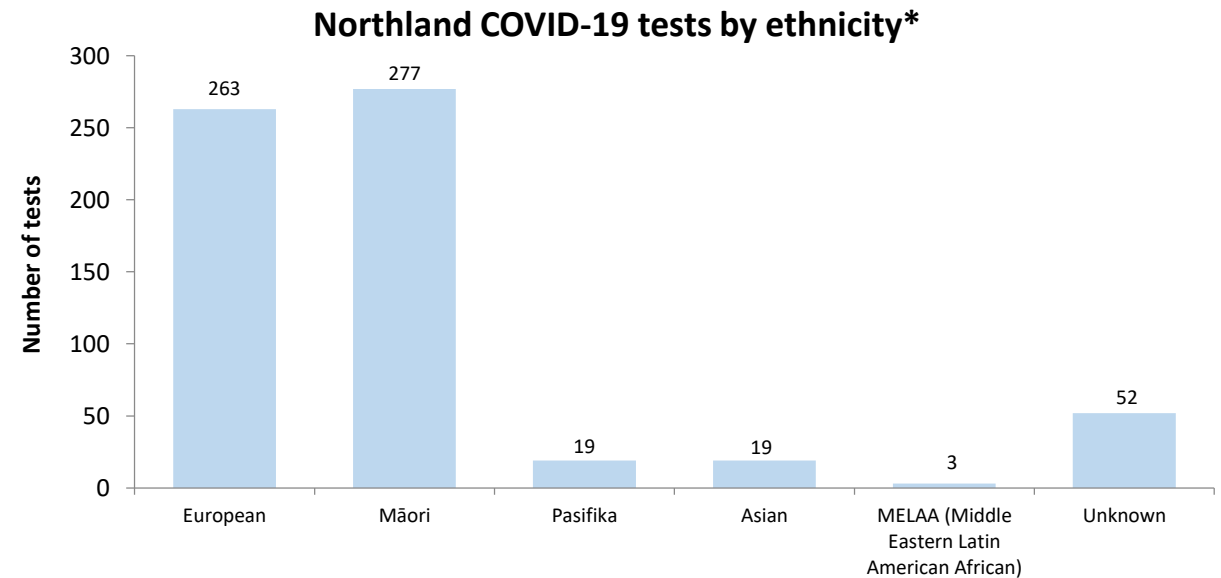
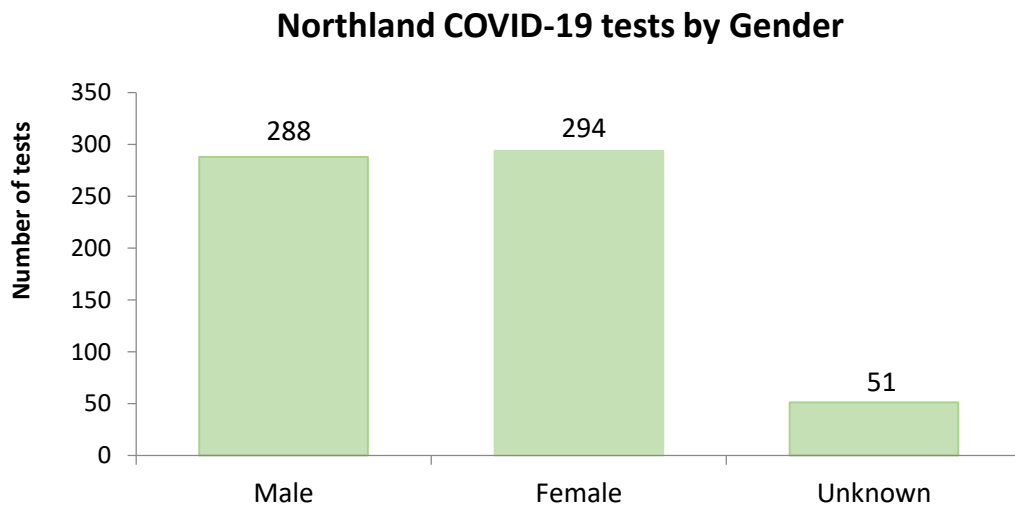
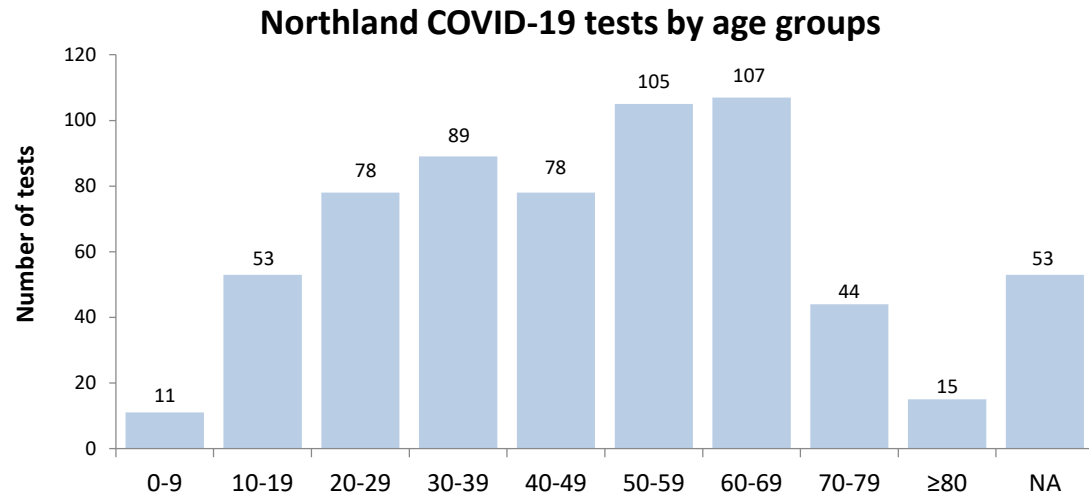
Of the 633 tests done on Sunday, 24 October 2021, 157 (24.8%) identified as contacts of Northland locations of interest related to the recent case (Code SURV-NL02)

Of the 633 tests done on Sunday, 24 October 2021, 15 (2.4%) identified as from the Ministry of Education and 87 (13.7%) identified as essential workers and 58 (9.2%) identified as travel across boundaries for personal reasons.

Below is an update on the testing results as at **0700 hours**, 24 October 2021:

Of the **818** tests done on **Friday**, 22 October, 2021:

- **794 (97.1%)** swabs have been processed and all results are negative
- **16 (2.0%)** swabs are 'pending'
- **2 (0.2%) Positive** results
- **6 (0.7%)** of the swabs were faulty

Of the **1,096** tests done on **Saturday**, 23 October, 2021:

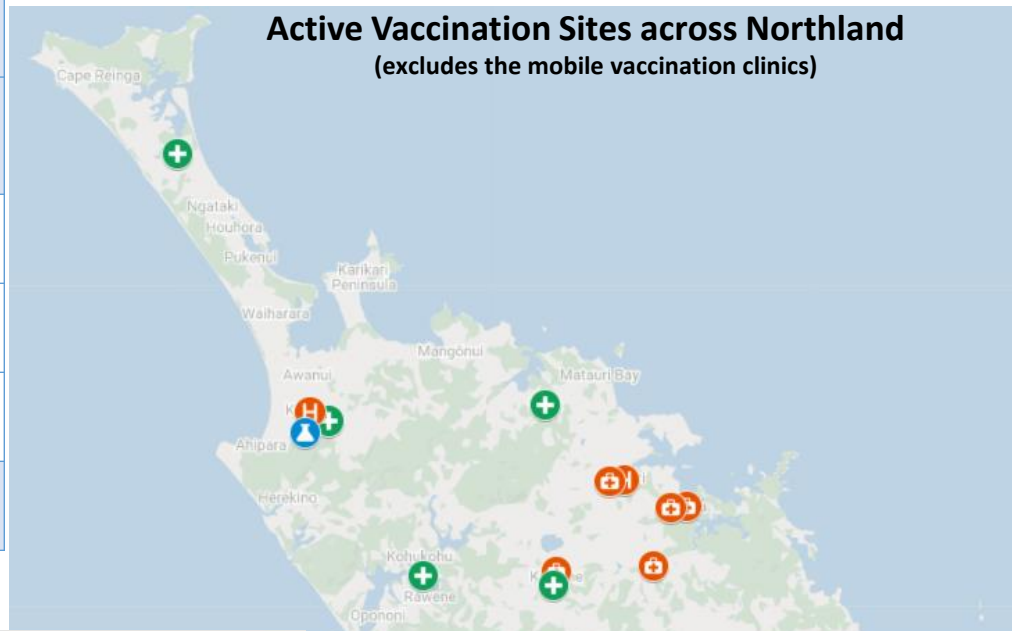
- **989 (90.2%)** swabs have been processed and all results are negative
- **96 (8.8%)** swabs are 'pending'
- **1 (0.1%) Positive** results
- **10 (0.9%)** of the swabs were faulty

Of the **633** tests done on **Sunday**, 24 October, 2021:

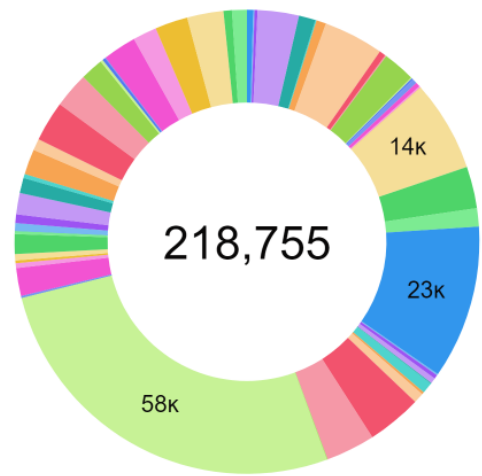
- **247 (22.5%)** swabs have been processed and all results are negative
- **381 (34.8%)** swabs are 'pending'
- **2 (0.2%) Positive** results
- **3 (0.3%)** of the swabs were faulty

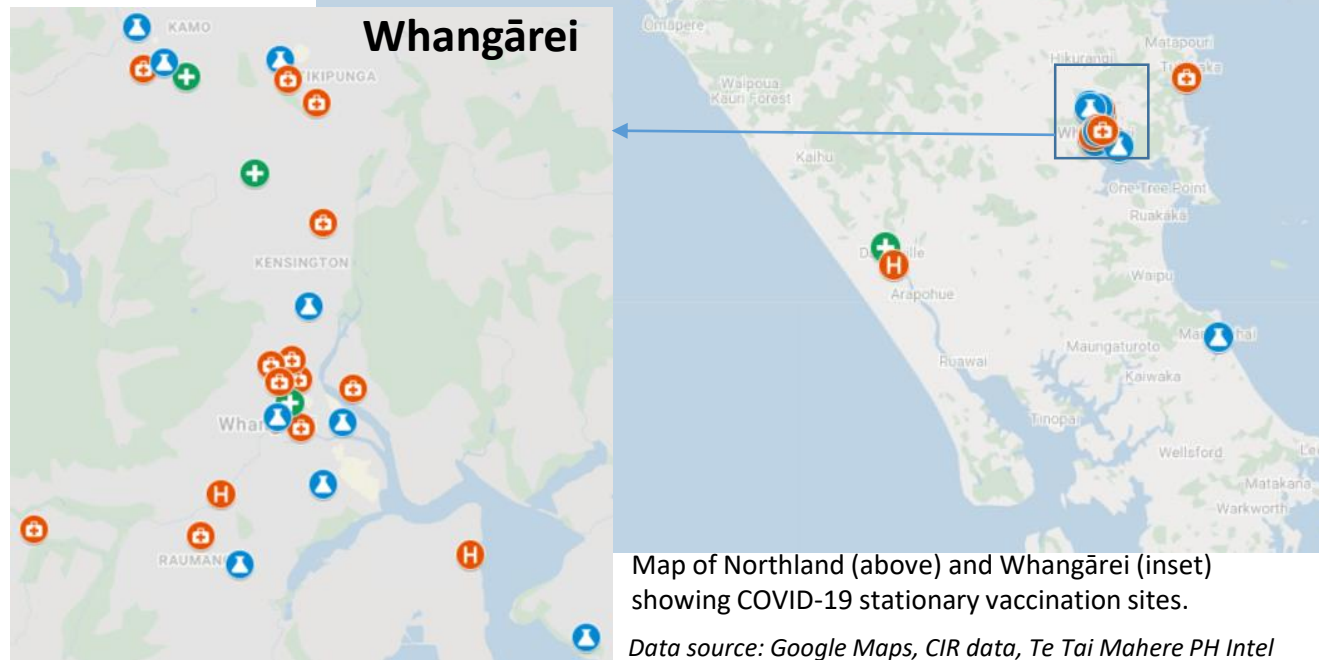


Vaccinations administered in Northland

 - ❖ 7 mobile outreach clinics

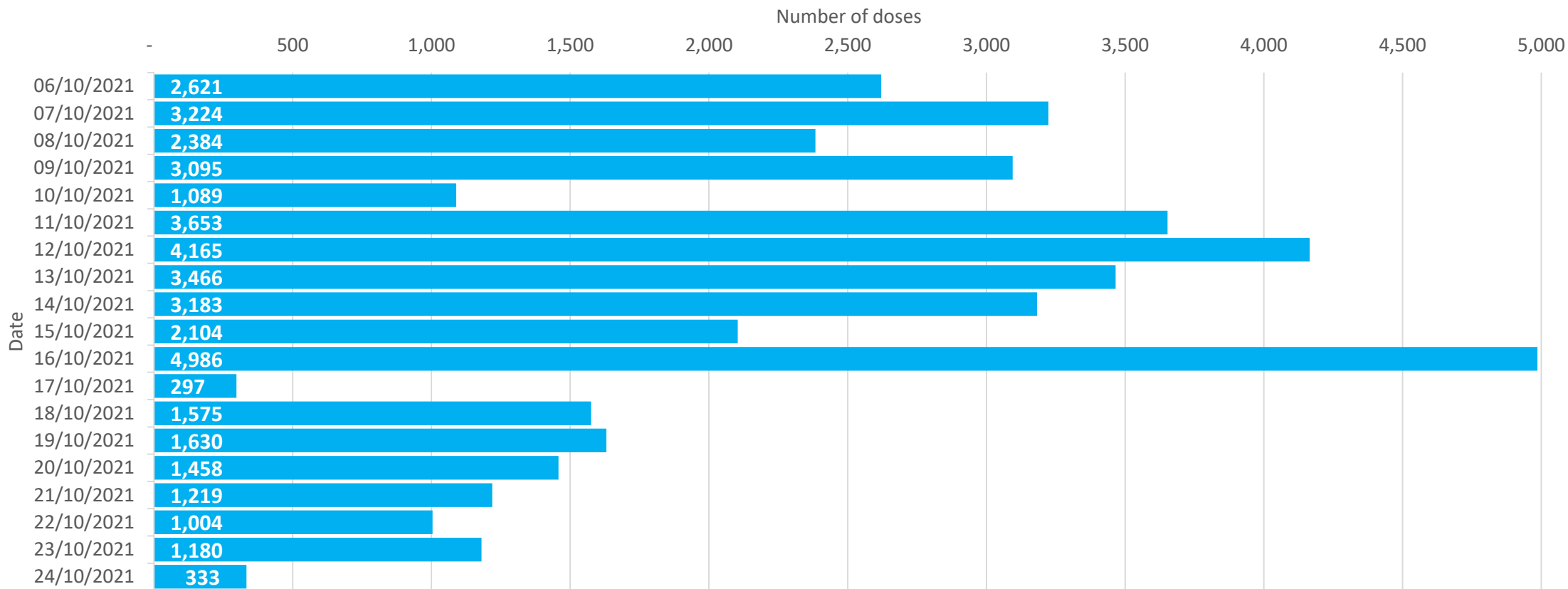


Map of Northland (above) and Whangārei (inset) showing COVID-19 stationary vaccination sites.

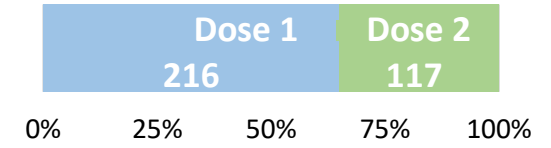
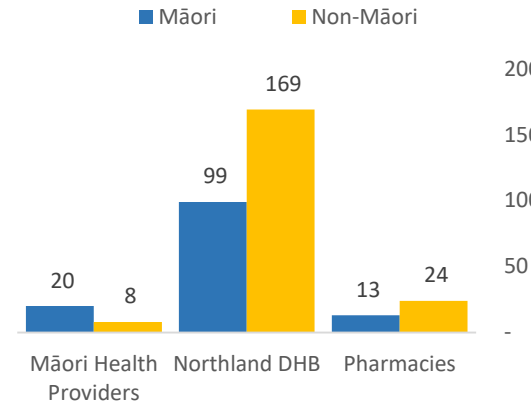

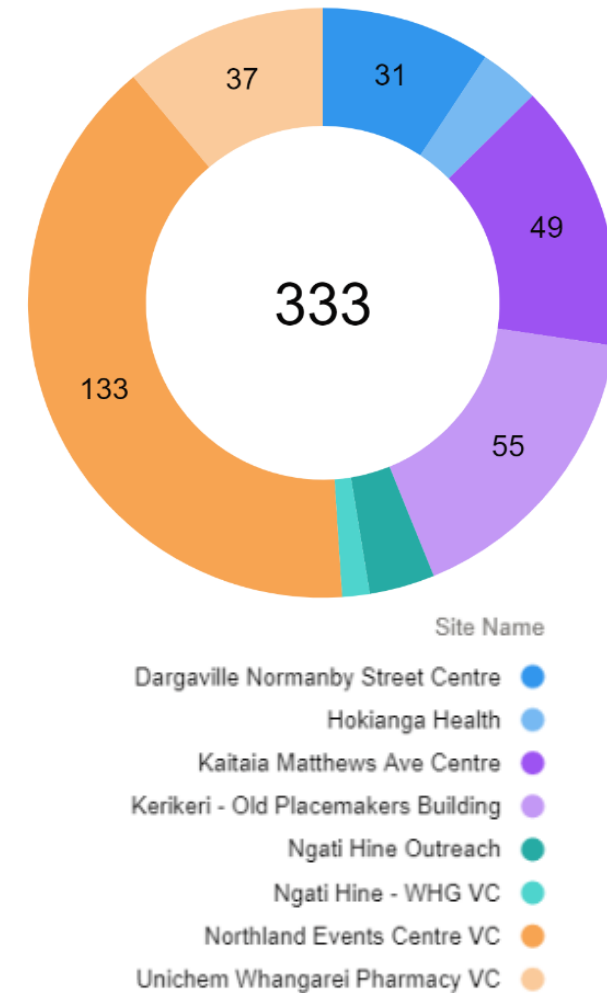
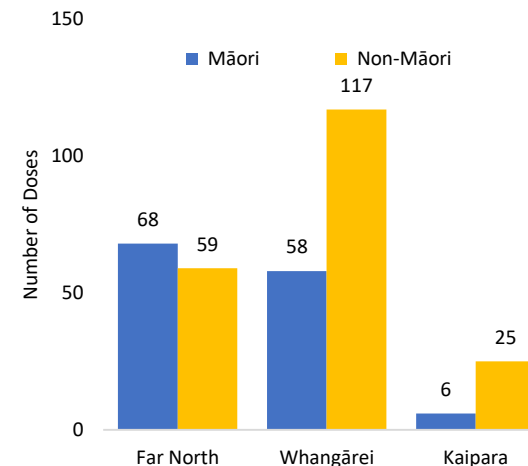
