Prepare for an apprenticeship or a job as a labourer on construction projects with this program which will get you work-ready. You'll learn the theory and practice underpinning the construction trades, and transferable knowledge like reading drawings, performing calculations and understanding carpentry terminology.

- Work safely and in accordance with compliance and regulatory requirements
- Read and use specifications and drawings to complete simple projects
- Perform basic calculations to complete a range of tasks
- Understand and apply basic building technology, the properties of timber, concrete, steel and composite products, interior and exterior linings and fixings
- Use construction and installation processes and techniques while carrying out carpentry projects
- Carry out assigned carpentry work in a project environment.

All applicants must:

- be at least 16 years old at the time the programme commences
- be able to read, write, and communicate in English at a basic level
- be physically able to complete the programme specific outcomes

Applicants for whom English is not a first language must have an IELTS score of 5 with no band score lower than 5; or an accepted international equivalence.
