

## Call for Expressions of Interest

## Te Taumata Hauora o Te Kahu o Taonui Iwi-Māori Partnership Board – Te Tai Tokerau

The Pae Ora (Healthy Futures) Act, 2022 provides a statutory purpose and framework for recognising Iwi-Māori Partnership Boards as a vehicle to exercise tino rangatiratanga and mana motuhake at a local level.

The intent of Iwi-Māori Partnership Boards (IMPB's) is to ensure that Iwi Māori have a consistent overview and contribution to developing solutions to advance better health outcomes for whanau, hapū and hapori Māori.

## Te Kahu o Taonui is calling for expressions of interest to contribute to the inaugural Iwi-Māori Partnership Board.

The boundaries for Te Taumata Hauora o Te Kahu o Taonui IMPB are 'Mai Tamaki ki Te Rerenga Wairua' and includes 12 Iwi Groupings (Ngāti Kuri, Te Aupōuri, Ngāi Takoto, Te Rarawa, Ngāti Kahu, Whaingaroa, Kahukuraariki, Ngāti Whātua, Ngātiwai, Te Roroa, Ngāpuhi with Ngāti Hine).

There are a total of twelve (12) seats in total that form Te Taumata Hauora o Te Kahu o Taonui.

Interim membership for the first year of the Taumata Hauora establishment include six (6) Iwi appointed seats, (Te Aupōuri, Ngāi Takoto, Ngāpuhi, Ngātiwai, Whaingaroa, Ngāti Whatua) and one (1) Mareikura (Dame Rangimarie Naida Glavish).

We welcome applications from candidates to fill 4 seats for the establishment year:

- 1 Member from the Māori Health Provider Sector (Northland)
- 1 Member from the Māori Health Provider Sector (Auckland)
- 1 Member with Hauora Māori Expertise
- 1 Member to be the Independent Chair
