Situational Awareness

MetService

- Gabrielle currently a Category 2 storm but will be upgraded to a Category 3 storm this morning
- Sunday forecasting heavy rain, strong easterly winds and heavy seas
- Monday forecasting heavy rain, gale force easterly winds, heavy seas and storm surge
- Tuesday forecasting heavy rain, strong south easterly wind and heavy seas
- Tracking towards northern NZ and may tend east of Northland/Auckland
- Expect coastal inundation in some areas
- May be upgrading to a red warning this afternoon
- MetService has a cautious approach and is planning for the worst but hoping for the best

Hydrology

- Most catchments are saturated from previous weather events
- All rivers running higher than normal
- In the event of heavy rainfall, expectation is for rapid runoff
- Expect rapid rise in river levels across the region
- Expect widespread flooding in the east

Waka Kotahi

- Brynderwyns open this morning but will be monitored and closed in the event of heavy rainfall impacts
- Monitoring subsidence areas in the region
- Road crews on standby
- If region goes to Red then comms will be put out asking for essential travel only
- Readiness planning

FENZ

- USAR teams prepared to support region
- Unimogs available and will be deployed in the Far North

Police

- Increase in shift capacity from Sunday onwards
- Deploying more staff in Kaitaia
- There will be an OC that will be supported by Tony Hill for their EOC

ST Johns

- Increase in staffing from Sunday onwards
- Working with Auckland region
- Supporting the Far North areas
- Leadership team in place
