# The vision

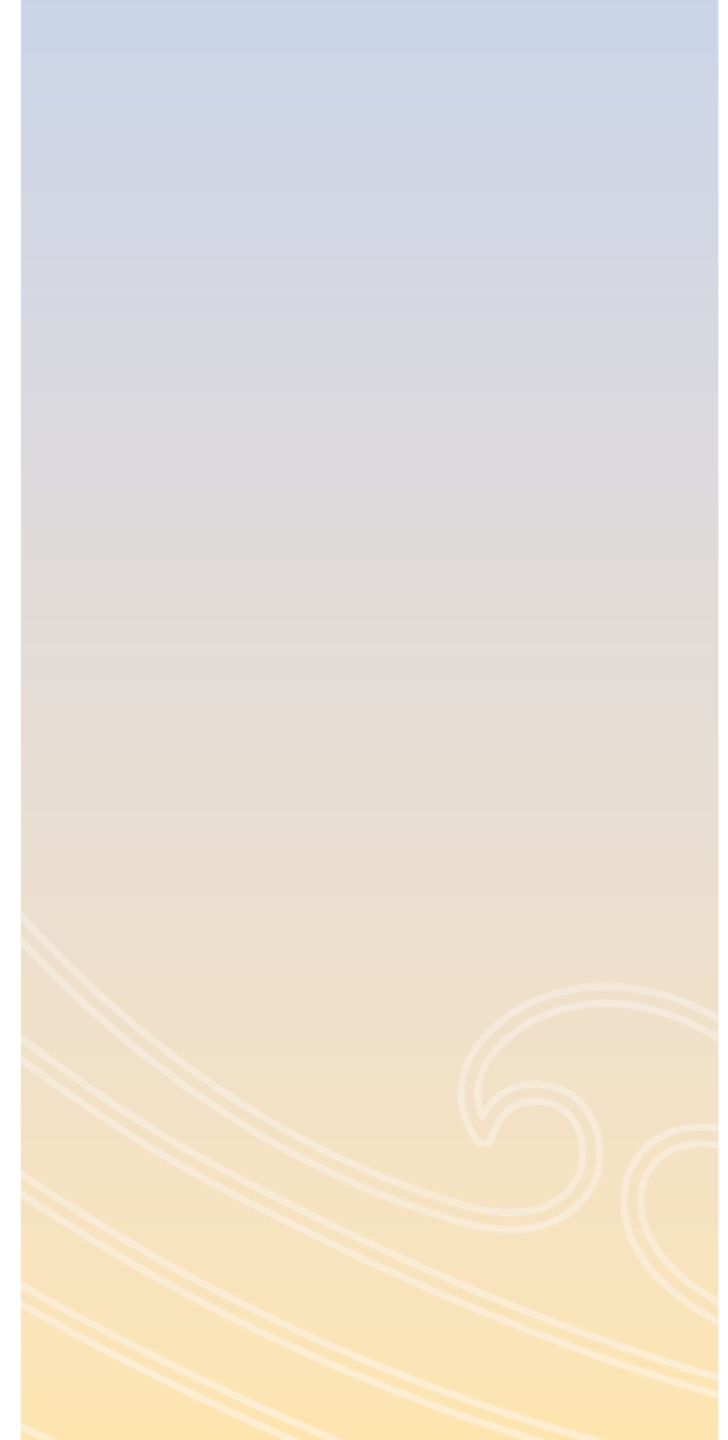
“Sustainable, high-quality and equitable care to New Zealanders in their local communities, underpinned by Te Tiriti” (Cabinet paper)

Wai 2575: Health system has failed to look after Māori

Can be bold – chance to transform, not just tinker



# What's happening

Manatū Hauora is leading policy mahi on primary and community care - looking at system settings

We are contributing to that mahi **and** completing our own mahi alongside

Policy work expected to run for 18 months from July 2023 to December 2024

Manatū Hauora work is underway across five broad areas:

- Empowering Hāuora Māori services
- Investment and funding settings
- Strengthening prevention and early intervention
- The structure and function of primary and community healthcare
- Workforce

# Our mahi on this important kaupapa

- Doing our own analysis taking a broader hauora perspective
- **System shifts needed to support hauora Māori?  
Best way to do this?**
- Drawing on what we have already heard from hāpori Māori, research, reviews, COVID-19 and the *Hauora* report (Wai 2575)
- Not starting from scratch
- **Very keen to work with you to develop and test ideas on options for system change**
